- Interviewing techniques for witnesses, victims, and involved parties.
- Documentation and record-keeping best practices.
- Analyzing data and identifying contributing factors.
- Introduction to different analysis tools and methodologies.

## Root Cause Analysis

- Introduction to root cause analysis RCA and its importance.
- Common RCA methodologies e.g., 5 Whys, Fishbone Diagram, Fault Tree Analysis.
- Practical exercises in applying RCA techniques to real case studies.
- Case studies and group discussions on successful RCA outcomes.
- Developing corrective and preventive actions CAPA based on root cause analysis.

## Day 4

### Reporting and Communication

- Effective reporting formats and templates.
- Writing clear and concise incident investigation reports.
- Presenting findings to stakeholders and management.
- Legal and ethical considerations in communication.
- Handling media and public relations during an investigation.

## Day 5

### Preventive Measures and Continuous Improvement

- Developing an action plan for implementing preventive measures.
- Monitoring and tracking the progress of corrective actions.
- Conducting a review of the investigation process for continuous improvement.
- Establishing a culture of safety and learning from incidents.
- Certification and closing remarks.
