- Identifying risks associated with pipeline operations.
- Emergency response strategies for spills.
- Containment measures for crude oil loss.
- Specialized equipment for spill management.
- Regulatory compliance and industry best practices for pipeline safety.

Day 5: Integrated Operations and Practical Applications

- Simulation exercises for commissioning and purging/filling operations.
- Hands-on practice with pigging and measurement techniques.
- Testing and sampling procedures.
- Emergency response scenario drills.
- Course conclusion, Q&A session, and participant feedback.





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
