2. Motors and electrical equipment
3. Hydraulic and pneumatic systems
4. Valves, piping, and process equipment
5. Practical troubleshooting case studies

Day 5: Advanced Problem Solving s Reliability Improvement

1. Recurring failures and equipment "bad actors"
2. Corrective vs. preventive maintenance actions
3. Failure elimination and reliability improvement
4. Troubleshooting documentation and reporting
5. Practical problem-solving exercises and case studies
